Provides, if the county fails or refuses to take action on the proposed project, for the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation to review and make a decision on the proposed project. Makes the provisions applicable only to a county with at least 500,000 residents for a four-year period. Appropriates funds. (HB1001 HD2)

Enacts the National Conference of Insurance Legislators market conduct surveillance model law, which establishes a framework for the insurance commissioner to conduct market conduct examinations of
