## AGENDA

Dual Use Technology refers to technology which has more than one use. For dual use companies, developing new ideas and cutting edge innovations are at the core of the work. Hawaii's dual use companies have been successful in winning Federal research funding to develop state-of-the-art technologies. However, Federal research dollars only fund research, and do not fund products ready for the marketplace. Thus, companies fall into an unsustainable cycle of creating research, instead of creating finished products.
