SB 668	RELATING TO EXCISE TAX ON HEALTH CARE. Exempts physician services, hospital charges, nursing services, and rehabilitation services from the county surcharge on state tax.	HTH, EDT, WAM
SB 1610	RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX.  Exempts private hospitals from the general excise tax provided that sixty per cent or more of the private hospital's annual patient population consists of uninsured, medicaid, and medicare patients. Requires the private hospital to submit verification to the department of taxation. Requires the department of taxation to adopt rules.	HTH, EDT, WAM
SB 1899	RELATING TO TAXATION.  Exempts medical care services, long-term care services, and non-prescription drugs from general excise tax liability.	HTH, EDT, WAM
SB 967	RELATING TO HEALTH. Provides a tax deduction for individuals who donate organs.	HTH, EDT, WAM
SB 1686	RELATING TO THE ANTARA MEDICAL TRUST FUND.  Provides an income tax credit for investment in the Antara medical trust fund. Creates the Antara medical trust fund.	HTH, EDT, WAM
