SB 852	RELATING	G TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.	HTH, WAM

Appropriates funds for additional urgent care services in the Ocean

View and Volcano communities of the island of Hawaii.

SB 12 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE RATE REGULATION. HTH, CPH

> Prohibits health insurance rates that are excessive, inadequate or unfairly discriminatory. Requires health care insurers to submit rate filings for approval by the insurance commissioner. Establishes

penalties and appeal procedures.

SB 53 RELATING TO MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS. HTH, CPH

> Includes marriage and family therapy among the mental illness and alcohol and drug dependence benefits required within the hospital and medical coverage offered under accident and sickness insurance

policies and similar insurance products.

SB 49 RELATING TO NATUROPATHY. HTH, CPH

> Requires the board of examiners in naturopathy to adopt a formulary and qualifications for administering natural medicines by injection, and to grant the authority to qualified naturopaths. Amends the definition of naturopathy accordingly. Establishes a temporary advisory committee to recommend a formulary and qualifications.

SB 244 RELATING TO HEALTH. HTH, CPH

> Requires department of health to adopt rules for beauty shops and health spas providing laser technology. Requires special license for laser technology application for an esthetician to use laser technology. Defines laser technology and health spa. Requires DOH to adopt rules

for special license.
