## DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

(Deferred from Monday, February 5, 2007)

SB 242

RELATING TO DENTAL CARE.

HSP/HTH, WAM

Expands coverage under the State's medicaid and QUEST programs to include comprehensive dental care for adults and appropriates funds to

provide the additional coverage.

SB 713

RELATING TO NURSE AIDES.

HSP/HTH, CPH

Establishes certification procedures for nurse aides employed in State licensed or State certified health care settings and medicare/medicaid

facilities.

SB 816

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUG COST CONTAINMENT AND AFFORDABLE ACCESS.

HTH/HSP, CPH

Requires the director of human services to establish a pharmacy best practices and cost control program including medicaid and other state public assistance health benefits plans, in which any public and private health plan may participate. Includes a prescription drug preferred list and prior authorization review process. Requires drug manufacturers to disclose economic benefits of \$25 or more provided to persons who

prescribe, dispense, or purchase prescription drugs.

SB 970

RELATING TO DENTAL HEALTH.

HTH/HSP, WAM

Appropriates funds for a grant-in-aid to Hawaii Primary Care Association to establish or expand community-based dental health clinics that are operated by federally-qualified health centers to provide a continuum of dental care to QUEST-eligible adults and children, the

developmentally disabled, and the uninsured.

SB 1176

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

HTH/HSP

Amends early intervention services law to be consistent with the reauthorized Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 2004. SB 1918

RELATING TO THE HAWAII CHILDREN'S HEALTH CARE

HSP/HTH, WAM

PROGRAM.

Creates a three-year pilot program in which the department of human services pays half of the premiums for the health care provided by a mutual benefit society to uninsured children thirty-one days to eighteen

years old who are ineligible for other state or federal health care

coverage. Appropriates funds. Sunsets June 30, 2010.

SB 1740

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

HSP/HTH, WAM

Appropriates funds to the preschool developmental screening program, the family health services division, and the injury prevention and control section to maintain existing staff and hiring additional staff

members.

SB 1798

RELATING TO PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATION.

HTH/HSP, CPH

Adds advanced practice registered nurses to the persons who must prescribe the psychotropic medication that the department of human services may not restrict or limit coverage for under section 346-59.9,

HRS. Makes technical amendments.
