SB 1701 RELATING TO RECYCLING.

ENE/IGM, WAM

Requires counties with a population of over 750,000 to establish a residential curbside recycling program; makes a grant-in-aid to the city

and county of Honolulu for this purpose.

SB 1865 RELATING TO INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

ENE/IGM, WAM

Permits the department of health to make grants from the deposit beverage container deposit special fund to the counties for the purchase, placement, maintenance, and collection of community

recycling bins and HI-5 fundraiser bins.

SB 654 RELATING TO RECYCLING.

ENE/IGM, WAM

Makes an appropriation for grants-in-aid to the counties to develop and

operate recycling programs.

SB 991 RELATING TO ENERGY.

ENE/IGM, WAM

Require agencies to provide priority handling and processing, and expedite action on all state and county permits required for renewable

energy projects.

SB 783 RELATING TO NOISE ABATEMENT.

ENE/IGM, WAM

Appropriates funds to the counties to develop noise abatement programs to increase enforcement of noise abatement laws.
