SB 1928	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR.  Authorizes the establishment of an investigative unit within the office of the auditor to conduct investigations involving alleged or suspected government waste, fraud, abuse, or malfeasance at the request of the legislature or upon the auditor's initiative; expands the powers of the office of the auditor; appropriates funds for the investigative unit. SB 1159	RELATING TO FAMILY COURT.  Appropriates funds to the Judiciary to implement the Family Court Parenting Plan Model as a pilot program on O'ahu.	JDL, WAM
SB 1231	RELATING TO THE WEED AND SEED STRATEGY.  Appropriates funds as a grant-in-aid to expand the weed and seed program to operate in the communities of Kalihi, Waipahu, and Ewa beach on Oahu, to be expended by the attorney general through a contract with the YMCA of Honolulu.	JDL, WAM
SB 1518	RELATING TO FAMILY COURT.  Increases fees for court-appointed counsel and guardian ad litem in family court cases. Requires the judiciary to provide the department of budget and finance with fees-related information, so that the department can approve the necessary vouchers. Appropriates funds.	JDL, WAM
SB 1526	RELATING TO JUDICIARY. Repeals the authority of the Judicial Salary Commission to determine judiciary administrators' salaries. Establishes salaries for Administrative Director of the courts and the Deputy.	JDL, WAM

#### RELATING TO VOTING.

JDL, WAM

Authorizes an election by mail voting system for Federal, State, and County elections. Requires elections to be conducted by mail when chief election officer, in consultation with County Clerks, determines an election by mail is economically and administratively feasible.

Makes appropriations.

## RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

JDL, WAM

Creates comprehensive public funding for elections to the State House of Representatives; establishes qualifications, limitations on funding and use of funds, reporting requirements, amends chapter 11, part XII

to reflect changes.
