Reduces from \$25,000 to \$5,000 the applicability threshold of service contract wage, hour, and working condition requirements. Provides certain exemptions for nonprofits. Requires wages providing an annual income of at least the U.S. poverty guideline for Hawaii for a family of four. Includes provisions enhancing employees' ability to

organize. (HB760 HD2)

Amends definitions of "closing", "covered establishment", and HD1

"employer". Requires employer to notify employees of divestiture. Imposes penalties for failure to notify employees of business closing.

Allows police officers to receive a maximum retirement allowance that
