## ENVIRONMENT-SENSITIVE BRIDGE ENGINEERING

The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) estimates that "47 percent of Hawaii's bridges are structurally deficient or functionally obsolete." http://www.asce.org/files/pdf/reportcard/statesfifactsheets.pdf.
