UNFINISHED BUSINESS

H.B. No. 1290, HD 1:

Representative Caldwell moved that H.B. No. 1290, HD 1, pass Third Reading, seconded by Representative B. Oshiro.

Representative Ward rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Mr. Speaker, I rise in opposition. Mr. Speaker, this is the exact same bill that we heard in the Judiciary Committee on February 13. The wording is exactly the same. And no one in the gay community wanted this bill. This body now is bringing it to the Floor without a hearing, and it is the presumption that the gay community has changed its mind. If we believe that the gay community has changed its mind, it's a good yes vote. I believe the gay community said unequivocally they want same sex marriage or civil unions and not this bill, and that's why I'm voting no. Thank you."

Representative Bertram rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"I rise in strong support and I appreciate the former Representative's concern for the gay community. I think this actually, though, that was at the heat of the moment, that was during a time when they were looking at a civil unions bill and thinking that this was going to take away from that. And I think this also negates the fact that this is for everybody. This goes beyond the gay community because this is reciprocal beneficiaries. This is a good move just in the sense that something is happening that's going to expand rights for everybody and I certainly support it and I hope the other Members support it as well. Thank you."

Representative Pine rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"Just in strong support, Mr. Speaker. I just want to point out that the Hawaii Family Forum and the Roman Catholic Church of Hawaii is in strong support of this measure. The Hawaii Family Forum is a nonprofit, pro-family education organization committed to preserving and strengthening families in Hawaii. The Roman Catholic Church in Hawaii under the leadership of their Bishop Larry Silva represents over 230,000 Catholics in Hawaii.

"Basically, the rationale and purpose of the regional reciprocal beneficiaries legislation was to provide for important human needs. Reciprocal beneficiaries were by design, not just for legitimate couples *per se*, but were to be available to any two people who qualify, such as two elderly sisters or older folks with adult dependents. And so, Mr. Speaker, I think this is a good civil rights bill. I think it's a good bill for everybody and I urge the Members to vote in favor of it. Thank you."

Representative Chong rose in support of the measure with reservations, and asked that his written remarks be inserted in the Journal, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Chong's written remarks are as follows:

"Mr. Speaker, I stand in support with reservations. My reservations, Mr. Speaker are with the manner in which this bill, in its amended form was placed before us today."

Representative M. Oshiro rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for him, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Lee rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for her, and the Chair "so ordered."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and H.B. The House of Representatives reconvened at 2:33 o'clock p.m.

Representative Cabanilla, for the Committee on International Affairs presented two reports:

(Stand. Com. Rep. No. 1207) recommending that H.R. No. 22, as amended in HD 1, be adopted; and

(Stand. Com. Rep. No. 1208) recommending that H.C.R. No. 36, as amended in HD 1, be adopted.

Representative Caldwell moved that the reports of the Committee be adopted, and that H.R. No. 22, HD 1, and H.C.R. No. 36, HD 1, be adopted, seconded by Representative B. Oshiro.

Representative Pine rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"In support of 1207 and 1208. I rise in strong support of Stand. Com. Rep. No. 1207 and 1208. As you know, Mr. Speaker, there is currently an ongoing crisis in a place of the world known as Darfur. Darfur is like any other part of the world, it has children, mothers, and fathers and homes, but it has one thing that other places do not. It has more than its fair share of suffering and death.

"It has been said by some that we, as a Legislature, have no right to address other nations. I personally co-introduced this resolution because I believe telling other nations that genocide is wrong is simply the right thing for us to do.

"A great leader, Mr. Speaker, named Ronald Reagan, once said, "Above all, we must realize that no arsenal, or no weapon in the arsenals of the world, is so formidable as the will, moral, and courage of free men and women. It is a weapon our adversaries in today's world do not have." And so I encourage my colleagues to place their hearts upon the ultimate freedom and vote in favor of these resolutions. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."

Representative Cabanilla rose in support of the measure and asked that her written remarks be inserted in the Journal, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Cabanilla's written remarks are as follows:

"Mr. Speaker, I am in strong support of Standing Committee Report No. 1207 and 1208 for House Resolution 22 and House Concurrent Resolution 36, "MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL, UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES, EUROPEAN UNION, GOVERNMENT OF SUDAN, JANJAWEEED MILITIA, SUDANESE LIBERATION ARMY, JUSTICE EQUALITY MOVEMENT, AND SUDAN PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY REGARDING THE CONFLICT IN THE DARFUR REGION OF WESTERN SUDAN."

"I am very proud to say that these amended resolutions which stand before the House Floor today are the result of very close cooperation, collaboration, and research by my staff and several nongovernmental organizations over the course of several weeks. My original intent in introducing these resolutions was to make a declaration to the suffering people of Darfur that there are people – even as far away as Honolulu, Hawaii – who love them and are unwilling to see them left to die and languish under the pall of genocide. The question, however, was how to state that declaration in a way that not only projected the Aloha spirit of compassion, but also made substantive recommendations for how to bring about peace in the region. That task was given to my legislative aide and international organizations policy advisor, Daniel Paul de Gracia II, who liaised with the Center For Moral Clarity, Human Rights Watch, Darfur Genocide.org, Pearce Aerospace, several faith-based organizations, and even an expert at the University of Texas at San Antonio, Dr. Mansour O. El-Kikhia of the College of Liberal and Fine Arts, who himself was a Libyan defector who escaped Africa by commandeering an aircraft and flying it to Italy under the radar floor of the Libyan Air Force. The language we are voting on today is the product of all their collective efforts.

"The crisis in Darfur is one that demands immediate attention. Women and children have had their arms and legs chopped off to leave them permanently disfigured. Men have been shot in their groins to emasculate and dehumanize them, and left to bleed out in the fields. Whole villages have been decimated by air strikes by Russian supplied Mi-24 "Hind" attack helicopters – the same one featured in such war films as Red Dawn, Rambo III, and Blood Diamonds – and Antonov cargo planes modified to drop bombs out of their rear cargo pallet doors. Even international relief aircraft performing humanitarian flights are not safe, as the Sudanese Air Force operates advanced MiG-29 Fulcrum fighters equipped with infrared search and track (or "IRST") sensors which provide targeting data directly to a pilot's helmet, allowing a Sudanese pilot to "lock on" and immediately send a missile to destroy any aircraft his eyes look at, allowing engagement of even American-made F-117 stealth fighters and BGM-109 Tomohawk Land Attack Missiles. The original resolution asked simply for the United Nations, European Union, and North Atlantic Treaty Organization to "pursue policies directed at ending the ongoing conflict in Darfur." But my advisor, Daniel Paul de Gracia II, suggested that one of the keys to stopping the destruction of villages and the regular interception of humanitarian flights was to call upon the European Union – with their new and highly sophisticated aircraft such as the Rafale, Eurofighter Typhoon, and Saab Gripen – to intervene in the region by deploying a No-Fly-Zone over the Darfur Region. This is just one of many examples of how the amended resolution is so much

stronger and so much better than the original draft, and why I call upon my colleagues to stand in strong support of this call to action.

"Mr. Speaker, there are some that say that the 21st Century represents the end of history: a time in which all of the great devotions, ideas, and visions are behind us. But I assert to you and to the Members of the House that we haven't run out of history quite yet. We have a chance to make history and save lives with HR22 and HCR36. The great poet Victor Hugo said, "*On résiste à l'invasion des armées; on ne résiste pas à l'invasion des idées*" – "One can resist an invasion of armies, but one cannot resist an invasion of ideas." HR22 and HCR36 represent the idea that genocide is wrong, that human life is precious, and that we are all part of one great, big, body, and when one part of the body hurts – all of it hurts.

"HR22 and HCR36 inspire a temper of the will, a quality of the imagination, a vigor of the emotions, a freshness of the deep springs of life, and a temperamental predominance of courage over timidity. They create in your heart the sense of wonder, the unflinching hope of making a difference, and the joy and inspiration of life itself. Consider, Mr. Speaker, the first "Be It Resolved" of the amended draft:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that to form a more perfect world, establish justice, ensure domestic and international tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish the following recommendations by resolution to the following entities and organizations, on behalf of the people of Darfur, who have suffered for decades under the shadow of famine, warfare, and strife:"

"Mr. Speaker, those words capture the essence of what this resolution is about, and why you and I are here. We fight for men and women whose poetry is not yet written, but which will presently be as enviable and as renowned as any. On behalf of all mankind, Mr. Speaker, fellow colleagues, vote yes for HR22 and HCR36."

Representative Ward rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"I also rise in strong support of these two resolutions. Mr. Speaker, I'll just point out to the body for those here or those outside, or those who will be listening. Yes, resolutions have no legal binding power, but we have to remember in history that it was a resolution that essentially started the Vietnam war, the resolution of the Gulf of Tonkin. And ask any Hawaiian if the resolution called the Hawaiian Apology means anything to them, if people take resolutions lightly. Thank you, Mr. Speaker."

Representative Lee rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"I stand in strong support. I would like to say that I think it's particularly appropriate that we pass this Resolution today because it is International Women's Day today. I think women, above anyone, have suffered the most in Darfur.

"And I'd also like to just make a comment about something I read in the paper this morning that maybe it was a waste of time for the Legislature to deal with international issues. I think this is more than appropriate that we make this statement today. Thank you."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the reports of the Committee were adopted and H.R. No. 22, HD 1, entitled: "HOUSE RESOLUTION MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL, UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES, EUROPEAN UNION, GOVERNMENT OF SUDAN,

JANJAWEEED MILITIA, SUDANESE LIBERATION ARMY, JUSTICE EQUALITY MOVEMENT, AND SUDAN PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY REGARDING THE CONFLICT IN THE DARFUR REGION OF WESTERN SUDAN," was adopted, with Representatives Herkes, Mizuno, Sonson, Takamine and Thielen being excused; and
