# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 260, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is  
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) of section 2 to read:

4 "(a) There is established the Hawaii anti-trafficking task  
5 force. The anti-trafficking task force shall be comprised of  
6 the following:

7 (1) Individuals:

8 [~~1~~] (A) The attorney general, or the attorney general's  
9 [~~designees~~] designee;

10 [~~2~~] (B) The directors of health, human services, and  
11 labor~~7~~ and industrial relations, or their  
12 designees;

13 (C) The state public defender, or the state public  
14 defender's designee;

15 [~~3~~] (D) The chief of police of each county, or the  
16 chief's designee;

17 [~~4~~] (E) The prosecuting attorney of each county, or the  
18 prosecutor's designee;







1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2008.
