A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the family self-1 2 sufficiency program allows public housing residents and holders 3 of federal section 8 homeownership program rental vouchers to build savings in an escrow account to be used for the down 4 5 payment on a home or other uses. 6 The purpose of this Act is to support homeownership by 7 households receiving low-income housing assistance by exempting 8 these family self-sufficiency escrow accounts from asset tests 9 used to determine eligibility for public benefit programs 10 administered by the department of human services. 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 13 designated and to read as follows:
