

1 "Environmentally secure facility" means an enclosed
2 facility, such as a laboratory or greenhouse, in which
3 precautions exist to prevent the exchange of genetic material
4 between genetically modified crops and non-genetically modified
5 crops.

6 "Genetically modified" means alterations to a life form or
7 its living progeny at the nucleic acid level, using the
8 techniques collectively referred to as recombinant DNA
9 technology.

10 "Person" means an individual, corporation, partnership,
11 limited liability company, or any other legal entity.

12 "Recombinant DNA technology" means the transfer of genes,
13 regulatory sequences, or nucleic acid between hosts by the use
14 of vectors or laboratory manipulations and includes the
15 insertion, excision, duplication, inactivation, or relocation of
16 specific genes, regulatory sequences, or sections of nucleic
17 acid. This term does not apply to material or an organism
18 developed exclusively through traditional methods of breeding,
19 hybridization, or nondirected mutagenesis."



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007, and
2 shall be repealed on June 30, 2017.
