## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A REGULATORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS  
ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that small businesses  
2 constitute the vast majority of firms in the state and that  
3 reducing regulatory burdens on small businesses is a priority of  
4 the State. In 1998, the small business regulatory review board  
5 was created and charged with the responsibilities to review any  
6 rule adopted by a state agency at the request of a small  
7 business owner and to recommend to a state agency or the  
8 legislature any rule or legislative changes. The legislature  
9 notes that there are currently insufficient staff resources and  
10 technical expertise to provide all the required support for the  
11 small business regulatory review board to accomplish these  
12 objectives.

13           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for one  
14 boards and commissions administrative assistant position in the  
15 department of business, economic development, and tourism to  
16 assist the small business regulatory review board.



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$44,424 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the  
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
5 2008-2009 for one boards and commissions administrative  
6 assistant position within the department of business, economic  
7 development, and tourism to assist the small business regulatory  
8 review board.

9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
10 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes  
11 of this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2034.
