# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOBACCO.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§709-908 Tobacco; minors.~~ (1) It shall be unlawful to  
4 sell or furnish tobacco in any shape or form, including chewing  
5 tobacco and snuff, to a minor [~~under eighteen years of age~~].

6 (2) Signs using the statement, "The sale of tobacco  
7 products to persons under eighteen is prohibited", shall be  
8 posted on or near any vending machine in letters at least one-  
9 half inch high and at or near the point of sale of any other  
10 location where tobacco products are sold in letters at least  
11 one-half inch high.

12 (3) It shall be unlawful for a minor [~~under eighteen years~~  
13 ~~of age~~] to purchase, possess, or use any tobacco product, as  
14 described under subsection (1). This [~~provision does~~] section  
15 shall not apply [~~if a person under the age of eighteen,~~] to:

16 (a) Any minor, with parental authorization, who is  
17 participating in a controlled purchase as part of a  
18 law enforcement activity or a study authorized by the



1 department of health under the supervision of law  
2 enforcement to determine the level of incidence of  
3 tobacco sales to minors~~[ ]~~; or

4 (b) Possession or custody of tobacco by a minor in the  
5 course of delivery, pursuant to the direction of the  
6 minor's employer lawfully engaged in business  
7 necessitating the delivery.

8 (4) Any person who violates subsection (1) or (2), or  
9 both, shall be fined \$500 for the first offense. Any subsequent  
10 offenses shall subject the person to a fine not less than \$500  
11 nor more than \$2,000. Any minor [~~under eighteen years of age~~]  
12 who violates subsection (3) shall be fined \$10 for the first  
13 offense. Any subsequent offense shall subject the violator to a  
14 fine of \$50, no part of which shall be suspended, [~~or~~] and the  
15 [~~person shall~~] minor may be required to perform not less than  
16 forty-eight hours nor more than seventy-two hours of community  
17 service during hours when the [~~person~~] minor is not employed and  
18 is not attending school.

19 (5) For purposes of this section, "minor" means any person  
20 under eighteen years of age."



1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun, before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.



**Report Title:**

Tobacco; Minors

**Description:**

Makes it unlawful for minors (persons under age 18) to possess or use tobacco products. Exempts minors when lawfully delivering tobacco products or participating in a law enforcement activity. Subjects violator of a subsequent offense to possible, rather than mandatory, community service. Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1057 HD1)
