## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII NATIONAL GUARD.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 121-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§121-39 Pay of officers and warrant officers while on
4	active duty. Officers and warrant officers of the army or air
5	national guard while on active duty of the State shall receive
6	the pay and allowances of officers and warrant officers of
7	similar grades of the United States [army] Army and [air force,
8	Air Force, respectively; provided that [no]:
9	(1) The State shall allow officers and warrant officers to
10	directly deposit their pay by electronic means to
11	their personal banking accounts; and;
12	(2) No pay or allowances shall be made to officers or
13	warrant officers for any service for which they
14	receive military pay and allowances from the United
15	States."
16	SECTION 2. Section 121-40, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended to read as follows:

1	"\$121-40 Pay of enlisted personnel while on active duty.
2	Enlisted personnel of the army and air national guard while on
3	active duty in the service of the State, except during periods
4	of annual field training or year-round field training, shall
5	receive the same pay and allowances as enlisted personnel of
6	similar rank in the United States [army] Army and [air force,]
7	Air Force respectively; provided that the [aggregate]:
8	(1) State shall allow enlisted personnel to directly
9	deposit their pay by electronic means to their
10	personal banking accounts; and
11	(2) Aggregate of the pay and allowances, computed on a
12	daily basis, shall in no event be less than the amount
13	equal to ten times the hourly wage specified in
14	section 387-2."
15	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
