A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-38.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] S6E-38.5[+] Kohala Historic Sites State Monument. (a)
- 4 There shall be a Kohala Historical Sites State Monument as an
- 5 historical site on the island of Hawaii [which] that shall
- 6 include a cluster of historical sites, including $[\tau]$ but not
- 7 limited to $[\tau]$ the Mookini Heiau, the Kamehameha birthsite, the
- 8 Kukuipahu Heiau, and, upon acquisition by the State, the
- 9 Mahukona historical sites. The monument shall be administered
- 10 by the department of land and natural resources and shall
- 11 consist of lands essential to the unimpaired preservation of the
- 12 visual, cultural, and historical aspects of the Mookini Luakini,
- 13 Kamehameha birthsite, Kukuipahu Heiau, and Mahukona historical
- 14 sites. The monument shall be for educational and cultural
- 15 purposes and there shall be public access for enjoyment of the
- 16 sites [which] that are included within the monument.
- 17 The real property to be included within the monument shall
- 18 include:
