A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a voter registration 2 deadline thirty days prior to an election does not encourage 3 participation in the electoral process and that many citizens do 4 not become passionate about the electoral process until after 5 the registration deadline. The legislature further finds that 6 election day registration will allow more citizens to 7 participate in the electoral process. 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide for voter 9 registration on election day; provided the voter can prove 10 residency in the district. SECTION 2. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 11 12 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 13 read as follows: 14 **Election day registration**. (a) Persons seeking 15 to vote on primary, special primary, special, general, or 16 special general election day may register on that election day 17 by appearing during the hours of voting in person at the polling
- 18 place for the precinct in which the person maintains residence,



1 by completing an application to register pursuant to section 11-2 15, making an oath in the form prescribed by the chief election 3 officer, and providing proof of residence. (b) Proof of residency may be provided by two of the 4 5 following: 6 (1) A valid Hawaii driver's license; 7 (2) A Hawaii civil identification certificate issued 8 pursuant to section 846-30; 9 (3) A utility bill showing the voter's current home 10 address; 11 A bank statement showing the voter's current home (4)12 address; or 13 (5) A valid student identification that: 14 (A) Shows proof of having met the requirements of 15 section 304A-402; and 16 Contains a photograph of the person identified. (B) 17 Nothing in this section shall allow a person to avoid 18 fulfilling any requirements of registration pursuant to section 19 11-15." SECTION 3. Section 11-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 20 21 amended by amending its title and subsections (a) and (b) to 22 read as follows:

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- 1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 6 elections for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050;
- 10 provided that section 4 shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
