A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WATER SYSTEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "\$163D- Agricultural water systems; acquisition. (a) 5 The corporation may acquire or contract to acquire by grant, 6 purchase, or gift the real, personal, or mixed property of an 7 agricultural water system to provide water for irrigation of 8 agricultural lands. 9 (b) The owner of an agricultural water system to be 10 acquired pursuant to subsection (a) shall provide a description of the system sufficient to identify the property being 11 12 acquired, including a map of the land and description of the metes and bounds and other information required for recordation 13 14 under chapter 502. The conveying of the property of an 15 agricultural water system to the corporation shall be exempt 16 from county subdivision requirements."
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 163D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:

7		own, hold, sell, assign, transfer, convey, exchange,
8		lease, or otherwise dispose of, or encumber any
9		project;
10	(9)	In cooperation with the department of agriculture,
11		pursuant to chapter 167, or otherwise through direct
12		investment or coventure with a professional investor
13		or enterprise or any other person, or otherwise, to
14		acquire, construct, operate, and maintain water
15		facilities for conveying, distributing, and
16		transmitting water for irrigation and agricultural
17		uses at rates or charges determined by the
18		corporation; provided that:
19		(A) This chapter shall not be construed to permit or
20		allow the department of agriculture or [any] the
21		agribusiness development corporation to:

1		(i)	Amend or modify rights or entitlements to
2			water as provided for by Article XI, section
3			7, of the Constitution of the State of
4			Hawaii, or the Hawaiian Homes Commission
5			Act, 1920, as amended, and chapter 168;
6		(ii)	Diminish or abridge the traditional and
7			customary rights of ahupua`a tenants who
8			inhabited the Hawaiian Islands prior to 1778
9			under sections 1-1 and 7-1; and
10		(iii)	Impair, abridge, or terminate the legal
11			rights or interests to water and its uses,
12			whether by lease, easement, or other means,
13			which are possessed or held by organizations
14			whose primary purpose is to benefit people
15			of Hawaiian ancestry; and
16		(B) All ı	usage of water shall be in accordance with
17		chapt	ter $[+]$ 174C $[+]$ and other applicable laws $[+]$

19	(10)	Assist agr	ricultural enterprises by conducting detailed
20		marketing	analysis and developing marketing and
21		promotiona	al strategies to strengthen the position of

3	(11)	Carry out specialized programs designed to develop new
4		markets for Hawaii agricultural products;
5	(12)	Receive, examine, and determine the acceptability of
6		applications of qualified persons for allowances or
7		grants for the development of new crops and
8		agricultural products, the expansion of established
9		agricultural enterprises, and the altering of existing
10		agricultural enterprises;
11	(13)	Coordinate its activities with any federal or state
12		farm credit programs;
13	(14)	Grant options to purchase any project or to renew any
14		lease entered into by it in connection with any of its
15		projects, on the terms and conditions it deems
16		advisable;
17	(15)	Provide advisory, consultative, training, and
18		educational services, technical assistance, and advice
19		to any person, partnership, or corporation, either
20		public or private, in order to carry out the purposes
21		of this chapter, and engage the services of

1		consultants on a contractual basis for rendering
2		professional and technical assistance and advice;
3	(16)	Procure insurance against any loss in connection with
4		its property and other assets and operations in such
5		amounts and from such insurers as it deems desirable;
6	(17)	Accept gifts or grants in any form from any public
7		agency or any other source; and
8	(18)	Do all things necessary or proper to carry out the
9		purposes of this chapter.
10	(b)	The corporation shall develop, promote, assist, and
11	market ex	port crops and other crops for local markets."
