## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of 2 a revolving fund for the department of education's office of
- 3 Hawaii child nutrition program is necessary to account for the
- 4 receipts from the administrative fees charged to the recipient
- 5 agencies for the distribution of federal commodity foods.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the United States
- 7 Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service, Western
- $oldsymbol{8}$  Region Office monitors and approves the administrative fees
- 9 charged to the recipient agencies. However, federal
- 10 legislation does not allow the department of education to expend
- 11 federal moneys for the operations of the state contracted
- 12 warehouses.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for
- 14 the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support
- 15 the administration and operation of the department of education
- 16 food distribution program.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	"§302A- Food distribution program revolving fund. (a)	
5	There is	established the food distribution program revolving
6	fund to be administered by the department of education.	
7	(b)	The food distribution program revolving fund shall
8	<pre>consist of:</pre>	
9	(1)	Administrative fees collected by the department for
10		administering and operating the food distribution
11		program;
12	(2)	All interest earned on the deposit or investment of
13		moneys in the food distribution program revolving
14		fund; and
15	(3)	Any other moneys made available to the food
16		distribution program revolving fund from other
17		sources.
18	(c)	The revolving fund shall be used by the department for
19	the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to pay for	
20	services	rendered by the state contracted warehouses for the
21	distribution of federal commodity foods to recipient agencies.	

1 (d) The balance in the food distribution program revolving 2 fund shall not exceed \$2,000,000 at the end of any fiscal year. 3 (e) The food distribution program revolving fund shall not 4 be used for: 5 (1) Consultant or personal services rendered; (2) Travel expenses that may include conference 6 registration, per diem, and airfare; or 7 (3) Purchase of furniture, equipment, computer hardware, 8 9 or office supplies." SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the food 10 11 distribution program revolving fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the 12 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the payment of services provided by state 14 contracted warehouses for the distribution of federal commodity 15 foods to recipient agencies under the department of education 16 17 food distribution program. 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 19 of education for the purposes of this Act. SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 20

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.

## Report Title:

DOE; Revolving Fund; Food Distribution Program

## Description:

Establishes food distribution program revolving fund to support the administration and operation of the food distribution program. Fund is not to exceed \$2,000,000 from revenues generated. Makes appropriation. (HB13 HD1)
