A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that neighborhoods across 2 the State are experiencing an increase in the number of homeless 3 individuals living in the streets and parks. The housing crisis is affecting many individuals and families across the State 4 5 including seniors, those with disabilities, and the working 6 poor. An estimated 21,890 units, 15,590 on Oahu alone, are 7 projected to be needed for households with less than eighty per cent of median income. It is imperative that in the planning 8 9 for housing and homeless services we not forget those with the 10 lowest incomes in our State. 11 SECTION 2. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 12 "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under 13 14 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit 15 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for 16 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists 17 by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year: 18 Ten per cent shall be paid into the land conservation (1)19 fund established pursuant to section 173A-5;

- 7 support services for the homeless population located at homeless
- 8 shelters.
- 9 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,000,000, or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
- 12 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 13 year 2008-2009, to provide continual operational funds to
- 14 provide matching funds for Shelter Plus Care grants.
- 15 SECTION 9. The sums appropriated in section 4 of this Act
- 16 shall be expended by the Hawaii housing finance and development
- 17 corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 10. The sums appropriated in sections 5 through 8
- 19 shall be expended by the Hawaii public housing authority for the
- 20 purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
