A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that neighborhoods across 2 the state are experiencing an increase in the number of homeless 3 individuals living in the streets and parks. The housing crisis 4 is affecting many individuals and families across the state, including seniors, those with disabilities, and the working 5 6 poor. An estimated twenty-one thousand eight hundred and ninety 7 units, fifteen thousand five hundred and ninety on Oahu alone, 8 are projected to be needed for households with less than eighty 9 per cent of the median income. It is imperative that planning 10 for housing and homeless services include those with the lowest 11 incomes in our state. 12 The purpose of this Act is to permanently increase the 13 conveyance tax allocation to the rental housing trust fund and 14 appropriate funds for various housing and homeless services. 15 SECTION 2. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected each 18 fiscal year under this chapter shall be paid into the state 19 treasury to the credit of the general fund of the State, to be HB150 HD2 HMS 2007-2519

- 9 2008-2009 to provide continual operating funds for emergency and
- 10 transitional shelters to maintain and enhance support services
- 11 for the homeless population located at homeless shelters.
- 12 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 15 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 16 fiscal year 2008-2009 to provide continual operational funds to
- 17 provide matching funds for shelter plus care grants.
- 18 SECTION 9. The sums appropriated in section 4 shall be
- 19 expended by the Hawaii housing finance and development
- 20 corporation for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 10. The sums appropriated in sections 5 through 8
- 2 shall be expended by the Hawaii public housing authority for the
- 3 purposes of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
