
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4 or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 as follows:
4 (1) \$1 for the establishment of two full-time equivalent
5 (2.00 FTE) permanent instructional faculty at Leeward
6 community college;
7 (2) \$1 for the establishment of three full-time equivalent
8 (3.00 FTE) permanent instructional faculty at the
9 University of Hawaii at Manoa college of education;
10 (3) \$1 for the establishment of one full-time equivalent
11 (1.00 FTE) administrative, professional, and technical
12 personnel for Leeward community college and the
13 University of Hawaii at Manoa college of education;
14 and
15 (4) \$1 for educational equipment,
16 for additional resources to recruit, train, and retain
17 prospective education assistants, paraprofessionals, and
18 elementary and secondary teachers.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
2 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
