
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State of Hawaii
2 receives funds through the Ryan White Care Act, which was
3 enacted by Congress in 1990 and named after an Indiana teenager
4 who became infected with the human immunodeficiency virus while
5 receiving blood as part of his treatment for hemophilia. The
6 legislature also finds that additional funds are needed to
7 supplement moneys available through the Ryan White Care Act,
8 which provides for medical and psychosocial services for Hawaii
9 residents living with the human immunodeficiency virus or
10 acquired immunodeficiency syndrome and have low incomes or
11 little or no insurance. In light of a recent \$2,000,000 cutback
12 in federal funding for Hawaii's only acquired immunodeficiency
13 syndrome clinical trials program, the legislature further finds
14 that supplementary funding is necessary to provide assistance
15 with housing, food, dental care needs and other services that
16 are in jeopardy or currently underfunded.
