## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF BLIND, DEAF, AND DEAF-BLIND PERSONS IN THE STATE OF HAWAII.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are no
  current, accurate statistics on the number of blind, deaf, and
- 2 current, accurate statistics on the number of bring, dear, and
- $oldsymbol{3}$  deaf-blind persons in the State of Hawaii. Additionally, more
- 4 information is required regarding the needs of this population.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 6 human services to conduct a needs assessment for the blind,
- 7 deaf, and deaf-blind residents of Hawaii.
- 8 SECTION 2. (a) The department of human services shall
- ${f 9}$  conduct a needs assessment for the blind, deaf, and deaf-blind
- 10 community in Hawaii. The department of human services may
- 11 contract with a third party to conduct the survey.
- 12 (b) The needs assessment shall include:
- 13 (1) The total number of blind, deaf, and deaf-blind
- persons residing in the State and residing on each

- 16 (2) Data on the blind, deaf, and deaf-blind community in
- 17 Hawaii and nationwide; and

- 1 (3) Services required or desired by the blind, deaf, and
- deaf-blind community.
- 3 For purposes of the needs assessment, "deaf" and "blind" shall
- 4 have the same meaning as defined under section 235-1, Hawaii
- 5 Revised Statutes.
- 6 (c) The department of human services shall submit the
- 7 results of the needs assessment to the legislature no later than
- 8 twenty days prior to the convening of the 2009 regular session.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for a
- 12 survey to determine the total number of blind, deaf, and deaf-
- 13 blind persons residing in the State and residing on each island
- 14 of the state.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
