A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BREAST CANCER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "§431:10A- Hospital length of stay coverage; 5 mastectomies. Each policy of accident and health or sickness 6 insurance providing coverage for mastectomies shall provide 7 coverage for a hospital length of stay of at least forty-eight 8 hours in connection with a patient's recovery from a 9 mastectomy." 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to article 1 to be appropriately 12 designated and to read as follows: 13 "§432:1- Hospital length of stay coverage; mastectomies. 14 All individual and group hospital and medical service contracts 15 providing coverage for mastectomies shall provide coverage for a 16 hospital length of stay of at least forty-eight hours in

connection with a patient's recovery from a mastectomy."

- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 4 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
- 5 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the [State] state
- 6 after January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations
- 7 pursuant to this chapter, shall include benefits provided in
- 8 sections 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116,
- 9 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120, [and]
- 10 431:10A-121, and 431:10A- , and chapter 431M."
- 11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009, and
- 14 shall be repealed on June 30, 2020.
