# A BILL FOR AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR A PILOT PROJECT TO INCREASE BUS RIDERSHIP.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that ridership on The Bus
- 2 has trended downward since a high in 1994 of 77,338,147
- 3 passengers. While the decrease in ridership could be attributed
- 4 to any number of factors, including a strike and incremental
- 5 fare increases since 1979, a decrease in ridership is
- 6 unquestioned.
- 7 The legislature also finds that, as a mass transit option,
- 8 public buses have served to reduce the amount of traffic on
- 9 state highways. The City and County of Honolulu's Public
- 10 Transit Department estimated that one bus, which can accommodate
- 11 50 to 70 passengers at a time, removes 40 to 70 cars from the
- 12 road because the passengers are not driving cars.
- 13 As a continuing part of the solution to deal with traffic
- 14 problems on state highways, increasing bus ridership can only
- 15 help with that situation. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act
- 16 is to establish a pilot project that will provide funding for

- 1 free bus ridership as a means to increase ridership on existing
- 2 public bus services.
- 3 SECTION 2. There shall be established a pilot project that
- 4 will provide funding to counties for free bus ridership as a
- 5 means to increase bus ridership on existing public bus services.
- 6 In order for a county to qualify for funding under this project,
- 7 the county must have existing public bus transit services in
- 8 existence at the time of the implementation of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. As an additional requirement to qualifying for
- 10 funding under this Act, a county must also, at a minimum, impose
- 11 a qualification requirement for individuals seeking to
- 12 participate in the pilot project that calls for presentment of a
- 13 state identification card or a state driver's license upon
- 14 application for participation in the pilot project. A county
- 15 may impose additional legal criteria for participation in the
- 16 pilot project.
- 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$\_\_\_\_ or so much
- 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 20 implementation of a pilot project that will offer free bus
- 21 ridership for 6 months.
