A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§37- Restriction or withholding of funds lawfully
5	budgeted and appropriated; prior written notice required. Prior
6	to the imposition of any restriction or withholding of any funds
7	under section 37-36 or 37-37, including any funds that are
8	lawfully budgeted and appropriated by the legislature that are
9	not contained in any allotment plan or request, the governor or
10	the director of finance shall provide prior written notice to
11	the joint legislative budget committee, established under
12	section 21F-3, of the proposed restriction, withholding, or
13	other action that will result in the nonexpenditure or
14	nonallotment of lawfully budgeted and appropriated funds and the
15	reasons therefor."
16	SECTION 2. Section 21F-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

amended to read as follows:

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         SECTION 3. Section 37-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
    amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

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               No appropriation to which the allotment system is
    applicable shall become available to any department or
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    establishment for expenditure during any allotment period until
    the department or establishment submits an estimate to the

    director of finance, at whatever time prior to the beginning of
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    the allotment period and in whatever form as the director may
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    prescribe, of the amount required to carry on the work of the
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    department or establishment during that period and until the
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    estimate is approved, increased, or decreased by the director
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    and funds are allotted pursuant to section 37-35[-]; provided
    that all allotment estimates required under this section shall

Requires prior written notice to the joint legislative budget committee of any intent to restrict or withhold any funds. Requires executive agency allotment estimates to include all amounts appropriated by the legislature.
