### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATE FILINGS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 431, article 10C, Hawaii Revised

  Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

  "S431:10C- Premium reductions for older insureds

  completing accident prevention course. (a) Any schedule of
- 6 rates or rating plan for motor vehicle insurance submitted to or
- 7 filed with the commissioner shall provide for an appropriate
- 8 reduction in premium charges, except for underinsured motorist
- 9 coverage, for those insureds who are sixty-five years of age and
- 10 older, upon the successful completion of a motor vehicle
- 11 accident prevention course meeting the criteria of the
- department of transportation with a minimum of eight hours, or
- 13 additional hours as determined by rule of the department of
- 14 transportation. An eight-hour program-learning self-instruction
- 15 course shall be made available in areas in which a classroom
- 16 course meeting the criteria of this section is not offered. The
- 17 classroom course may be conducted by a public or private agency
- 18 approved by the department of transportation. The self-

- 1 instruction course shall be conducted by an agency approved by
- 2 the department of transportation to conduct classroom courses
- 3 under this section.
- 4 (b) All insurance companies writing motor vehicle
- 5 insurance in this State shall allow an appropriate reduction in
- 6 premium charges, except for underinsured motorist coverage, to
- 7 all eligible persons under subsection (a).
- 8 (c) Upon successfully completing the approved course, each
- 9 participant shall be issued, by the course's sponsoring agency,
- 10 a certificate that shall be the basis of qualification for the
- 11 discount on insurance.
- (d) Each participant shall take an approved course upon
- 13 the renewal of the applicant's driver's license in order to be
- 14 eligible for a continued reduction in insurance premium
- 15 charges."
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 19 development of criteria for a motor vehicle accident prevention
- 20 course.
- 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 22 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
