## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to article 10C to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§431:10C- Reduction in premium charges; motor vehicle
5	accident prevention course. (a) Any rates, rating schedules,
6	or rating manuals for the liability, personal injury protection,
7	and collision coverages of a motor vehicle insurance policy
8	submitted to or filed with the insurance commissioner shall
9	provide for an appropriate reduction in premium charges as to
10	those coverages for a three-year period after the principal
11	operator of the covered vehicle successfully completes a motor
12	vehicle accident prevention course approved by the department of
13	transportation. Any discount used by an insurer shall be
14	presumed appropriate unless credible data demonstrates
15	otherwise.
16	(b) The premium reduction required by this section shall
17	be effective for an insured for a three-year period after

1	insurer may require, as a condition of providing and maintaining
2	the discount, that the insured for the three-year period after
3	course completion not be involved in an accident for which the
4	insured is at fault.
5	(c) Upon successfully completing the approved course, each
6	person shall be issued a certificate by the organization
7	offering the course, which shall be used to qualify for the
8	premium discount required by this section.
9	(d) This section shall not apply in the event the approved
10	course is specified by a court or other governmental entity
11	resulting from a moving traffic violation.
12	(e) Each participant shall take an approved course every
13	three years to continue to be eligible for the reduction in
14	premiums."
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
