A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATIONS THAT PROVIDE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 176, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, is
- 2 amended by amending sections 4 and 5 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is
- 4 authorized, from time to time, including time subsequent to June
- 5 30, [2008] 2013, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 6 whatever principal amounts the department of budget and finance
- 7 shall determine to be necessary to refund the special purpose
- 8 revenue bonds authorized in section 2 and any refunding of
- 9 special purpose revenue bonds authorized in this section,
- 10 regardless of whether the outstanding special purpose revenue
- 11 bonds or refunding special purpose revenue bonds have matured or
- 12 are the subject of redemption or whether the refunding special
- 13 purpose revenue bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project
- 14 programs described in section 2. In making this determination,
- 15 the department of budget and finance shall comply with federal
- 16 law relating to the exemption from federal income taxation of
- 17 the interest on bonds of the nature authorized by this section.

- 1 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
- 2 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, [2008.]
- 3 2013."
- 4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2008.
