A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

	·
1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an estimated six
2	thousand children in the State of Hawaii have a parent in
3	prison. Many children of incarcerated parents experience grief
4	guilt, shame, fear, depression, and have difficulty sleeping or
5	concentrating. Although children need to maintain contact with
6	their parent, visits at correctional facilities can be
7	frightening for some children.
8	The purpose of this Act is to help maintain the well-being
9	of children of incarcerated parents and support their needs.
10	SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
12	and to read as follows:
13	"§346- Bill of rights for children of incarcerated
14	parents. Children of incarcerated parents shall be afforded
15	rights, which shall include the right:
16	(1) To be kept safe and informed at the time of the
17	<pre>parent's arrest;</pre>

(2) To be heard when decisions are made about the child;

1	(3)	To be considered when decisions are made about the
2		<pre>child's incarcerated parent;</pre>
3	(4)	To be well cared for in the incarcerated parent's
4		absence;
5	(5)	To speak with, see, and touch their incarcerated
6		<pre>parent;</pre>
7	(6)	To be supported as the child struggles with the
8		<pre>parent's incarceration;</pre>
9	(7)	To not be judged, blamed, or labeled because of the
10		parent's incarceration; and
11	(8)	To have a lifelong relationship with the parent."
