### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CANCER RESEARCH SPECIAL FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

16	There is estab	lished within the state treasury a special fund to
17	be known as th	e Hawaii cancer research special fund to be
18	administered a	nd expended by the University of Hawaii.
19	(b) The	moneys in the special fund shall be used by the
20	University of	Hawaii for the cancer research center of Hawaii's
21	research and o	perating expenses $[-]$ and capital expenditures.
