## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DNA.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 844D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 "§844D- Collection from persons arrested for a felony 5 offense. A person, except for any juvenile, arrested for a 6 felony offense shall provide buccal swab samples and print 7 impressions and, if required by the collecting agency's rules or 8 internal regulations, blood specimens, immediately at intake or 9 as soon as administratively practicable at the appropriate 10 custodial or receiving institution or program unless the 11 person's blood specimens or buccal swab samples, and print 12 impressions authorized by this chapter are already in the 13 possession of the department or have been recorded as part of 14 the state DNA database and data bank identification program." 15 SECTION 2. Section 844D-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 17 "(a) Any person, except for any juvenile, who is arrested

- 8 SECTION 3. Section 844D-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 "[+] \$844D-41[+] Retroactive application. Sections 844D-
- 11 31, 844D-33, and 844D-34 to 844D-37 shall have retroactive
- 12 application. Collection shall occur pursuant to sections 844D-
- 13 34 to 844D-38 regardless of when the crime charged or committed
- 14 became a qualifying offense pursuant to this chapter, and
- 15 regardless of when the person was arrested for or convicted of
- 16 the qualifying offense described in section 844D-31(a) or a
- 17 similar crime under the laws of the United States or any other
- 18 state, or pursuant to the United States Code of Military
- 19 Justice, for commission of a qualifying offense described in
- 20 section 844D-31(a) or a similar crime under the laws of the
- 21 United States or any other state."

- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
