A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KALOKO HOUSING PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a pressing 2 need to increase the availability of homeless shelters on the 3 island of Hawaii. The Big Island continues to have a relatively high proportion of homeless persons when compared to its overall 4 population. Existing homeless shelters and services are 5 6 stretched thin, with the population dispersed over large areas. In addition, the projected closure of the Ka Hale O Kawaihae 7 transitional housing program will exacerbate the situation and 8 reinforce the need for additional capacity. 10 To address this problem, the county of Hawaii has developed a plan to establish the Kaloko housing program. This facility 11 will be constructed on an 8-acre parcel north of Kaloko 12 Industrial Park, and will provide about 50 multi-family cluster 13 14 homes for families impacted by homelessness. The purpose of this Act is to provide the county of Hawaii 15 with the resources needed to fund the Kaloko housing program. 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 17

revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000,000 or so
