BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to offer greater
 choice to purchasers of accounting services, making it easier
 for certified public accountants to provide services to clients
 in a state other than the certified public accountant's own home
 state.

6 SECTION 2. Section 466-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

8 "(c) The board may grant a temporary permit to actively
9 engage in the practice of public accountancy [to] or may allow
