A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that foster children
 2 often need assistance in acquiring independent living skills and
- 3 transitional housing once they are ready to leave foster care.
- 4 A high number of foster children end up becoming homeless once
- 5 they turn eighteen. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 6 funds to the department of human services to provide independent
- 7 living skills training and transitional housing for foster
- 8 children and children being released from foster care.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 12 independent skills training for foster children and children
- 13 being released from foster care.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 17 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum, or so much thereof
- 2 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
- 3 the department of human services for the purpose of constructing
- 4 transitional housing for foster children and children being
- 5 released from foster care.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
- 9 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 10 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
- 11 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 12 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.
- SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
