A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that foster youth often
- 2 need assistance in acquiring independent living skills and
- 3 transitional housing once they are ready to leave foster care.
- 4 A high number of foster youth become homeless once they turn
- 5 eighteen.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 7 department of human services to provide independent living
- 8 skills training and housing vouchers or assistance for foster
- 9 youth and youth being released from foster care.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 13 independent skills training for foster youth and youth being
- 14 released from foster care.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 human services for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
- 4 the department of human services for the purpose of providing
- 5 housing vouchers or other financial support for housing to allow
- 6 foster youth or youth being released from foster care to choose
- 7 their own residence.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
