BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§448-A Prohibition on interference. (a) No person or
5	entity without a license issued pursuant to this chapter shall
6	direct or interfere with a licensed dentist's judgment and
7	competent practice of dentistry.
8	(b) No dentist licensed pursuant to this chapter who
9	engages in the practice of dentistry in any form, shall permit a
10	person or entity, other than a dentist licensed pursuant to this
11	chapter, to direct, participate in, or interfere with the
12	licensee's practice of dentistry.
13	(c) The board shall establish a list of activities that
14	should be performed or controlled in the sole discretion of
15	dentists licensed pursuant to this chapter.
