A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is in the best 2 interests of the state to support the development and widespread 3 consumer acceptance of electric vehicles within the state. The growth in the use of electric vehicles will attain significant 4 5 reductions in air pollution, improve energy efficiency in 6 transportation, and reduce the state's dependence on imported 7 oil or petroleum products. The legislature also finds that 8 exempting electric vehicles from various requirements applicable 9 to conventional, internal combustion, engine-powered vehicles 10 may encourage operators to choose electric vehicles.

11 Act 290, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, directed the 12 department of transportation to establish and issue a special license plate to identify electric vehicles and exempted 13 14 vehicles bearing the license plate from the payment of certain 15 parking fees and high occupancy vehicle traffic restrictions. 16 In addition, Act 290 waived the motor vehicle registration fee and any license plate issuance fees for electric vehicles in the 17 18 state.

2	290 encourage the use of electric vehicles and advance the
3	State's policy of supporting the development and widespread
4	consumer acceptance of electric vehicles within the state;
5	however, these incentives should be reviewed every five years.
6	The purpose of this Act is to promote the use of electric
7	vehicles in the state by exempting those vehicles from parking
8	fees and high occupancy vehicle lane restrictions and exempting
9	neighborhood electric vehicles from motor vehicle registration
10	and licensing fees.
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
13	and to read as follows:

3	(b) The director of finance of the county in which the
4	electric vehicle is to be operated shall establish and issue a
5	special license plate to designate that the vehicle to which the
6	license plate is affixed is an electric vehicle.
7	(c) An electric vehicle to which a license plate issued
8	pursuant to subsection (b) is affixed shall be exempt from:
9	(1) The payment of parking fees, including those collected
10	through parking meters, charged by any governmental
