# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WELLS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to place a
- 2 moratorium on the issuance of permits for the construction of
- 3 wells intended to serve agricultural land parcels that are
- 4 likely to be "fake farms" or "gentleman estates."
- 5 The moratorium shall end when the first designation of
- 6 "important agricultural land" is made by the land use commission
- 7 pursuant to part III of chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 8 The legislature finds that, when the designation is made, the
- 9 State will have made significant progress in resolving the issue
- 10 of the appropriate use of agricultural land.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding chapter 174C, part VII,
- 12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, or any other law to the contrary, from
- 13 July 1, 2008, until the termination date, the commission shall
- 14 not issue any permits for the construction of a well that is
- 15 intended to provide water for domestic use to at least one
- 16 parcel of agricultural land that:
- 17 (1) Is five acres or less in size; and

- (2) Has or will have a dwelling on the parcel of
   agricultural land.
- 3 (b) Subsection (a) shall not apply to:
- 4 (1) A permit for well construction that is pending 5 approval on June 30, 2008; and
- 6 (2) A permit for the installation of pumps or pumping
  7 equipment that is pending approval on June 30, 2008, or
  8 is for a well existing on June 30, 2008.
- 9 SECTION 3. As used in this Act:
- "Agricultural land" means land in the agricultural district
  under chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- "Commission" means the commission on water resource
- management.
- "Domestic use" means the same as defined under section
- 15 174C-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 16 "Important agricultural land" means the same as defined
- 17 under section 205-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- "Installation of pumps and pumping equipment" for a well
- 19 means the same as defined under section 174C-81, Hawaii Revised
- 20 Statutes.
- 21 "Termination date" means the date on which the first
- 22 designation of "important agricultural land" is made by the land
