BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$28-10 Prohibition on private practice of law by the
- 4 attorney general, first deputy, and other deputies. (a) The
- 5 attorney general, the attorney general's first deputy, and other
- 6 deputies shall devote their entire time and attention to the
- 7 duties of their respective offices. They shall not engage in
- 8 the private practice of law, [nor] or accept any fees or
- $oldsymbol{9}$ emoluments other than their official salaries for any legal
- 10 services [-]; provided that, except for the attorney general's
- 11 first deputy, other deputies may provide pro bono legal services
- 12 if the pro bono legal services do not conflict with the duties
- 13 of the deputies' respective offices.
- 14 (b) This section shall not apply to any special deputy
- 15 employed on a part-time basis for a limited period."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
