## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "display fireworks" to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 ""Display fireworks" means any fireworks designed primarily
- 5 for exhibition display by producing visible or audible effects
- 6 and classified as display fireworks or contained in the
- 7 regulations of the United States Department of Transportation
- 8 and designated as UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335, and includes
- 9 salutes containing more than two grains (one hundred and thirty
- 10 'milligrams) of explosive materials, aerial shells containing
- 11 more than forty grams of pyrotechnic compositions, and other
- 12 display pieces which exceed the limits of explosive materials
- 13 for classification as "consumer fireworks". This term also
- 14 includes fused setpieces containing components, which together
- 15 exceed fifty milligrams of salute power. The use of display
- 16 fireworks shall be prohibited for use by any person who does not.
- 17 have a display permit issued by a county."

6	SECTION 3. Section 132D-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
7	amended to read as follows:			
8	"§132D-12 Sale to minors. It shall be unlawful for any			
9	person to offer for sale, sell, or give any fireworks or			
10	articles pyrotechnic to minors, and for any minor to possess,			
11	purchase, sell, or set off, ignite, or otherwise cause to			
12	explode any fireworks or articles pyrotechnic, except as			
13	provided in section 132D-13."			
14	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed			
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.			
16	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
