A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "display fireworks" to 3 read as follows: ""Display fireworks" means any fireworks designed primarily 4 5 for exhibition display by producing visible or audible effects and classified as display fireworks or contained in the 6 regulations of the United States Department of Transportation 7 8 and designated as UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335, and includes 9 salutes containing more than two grains (one hundred and thirty milligrams) of explosive materials, aerial shells containing 10 more than forty grams of pyrotechnic compositions, and other 11 12 display pieces which exceed the limits of explosive materials 13 for classification as "consumer fireworks". This term also 14 includes fused setpieces containing components, which together exceed fifty milligrams of salute power. The use of display 15 fireworks shall be prohibited for use by any person who does not 16 17 have a display permit issued by a county."
