BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 22	6- Objectives and policies for land development.	
5	(a) Plan	ning for land development in the state shall be	
6	directed	toward the achievement of the following objectives:	
7	(1)	To develop land in a manner that first and foremost	
8		places the health, interests, and concerns of the	
9		people of the State as the primary objective of land	
10		development;	
11	(2)	To provide healthy and livable housing alternatives	
12		for all individuals in the state; and	
13	(3)	To balance the quality of life with economic growth	
14		and land development.	
15	(b)	To achieve the land development objectives, it shall	
16	be the po	licy of the State that land development shall be guided	
17	by the fo	llowing smart growth principles:	
18	(1)	Creating a range of housing opportunities and choices;	
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1	(2)	Creating walkable neighborhoods;	
2	(3)	Encouraging community and stakeholder collaboration;	
3	(4)	Fostering distinctive, attractive communities with a	
4		strong sense of place;	
5	(5)	Making development decisions predictable, fair, and	
6		<pre>cost effective;</pre>	
7	(6)	Mixing land uses;	
8	(7)	Preserving open space, farmland, natural beauty, and	
9		<pre>critical environmental areas;</pre>	
10	(8)	Providing a variety of transportation choices;	
11	(9)	Strengthening and directing development toward	
12		existing communities; and	
13	(10)	Taking advantage of compact building design."	
14	SECTION 2. Section 226-58, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
15	amended to read as follows:		
16	"§22	6-58 County general plans. (a) The county general	
17	plans and development plans shall be formulated with input from		
18	the state	and county agencies as well as the general public.	
19	County general plans or development plans shall indicate		
20	[desired]	expected or projected population and physical	
21	development patterns for each county and regions within each		
22	county.	In addition, county general plans or development plans	
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- shall address the unique problems and needs of each county and 1
- 2 regions within each county. The county general plans or
- development plans shall further define applicable provisions of 3
- this chapter; provided that any amendment to the county general 4
- plan of each county shall not be contrary to the county charter. 5
- 6 The formulation, amendment, and implementation of county general
- plans or development plans shall take into consideration 7
- statewide objectives $[\tau]$ and policies $[\tau]$ set forth in this 8
- 9 chapter, and programs stipulated in state functional plans

- 11 County general plans shall be formulated on the basis
