RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall
2	conduct a	study on the feasibility of implementing homeless
3	solutions	, including but not limited to the following:
4	(1)	Establishing campgrounds statewide in which the
5		homeless could camp for indefinite periods of time;
6	(2)	Providing communal kitchens, bathrooms, and laundry
7		facilities, as well as hot and cold running water and
8		electricity in the homeless campgrounds;
9	(3)	Placing homeless campgrounds near bus routes or
10		providing shuttle connections to bus routes or
11		destinations;
12	(4)	Providing schools for children of homeless families,
13		either via bus transportation or satellite classrooms
14		in areas with high concentrations of homeless
15		children;
16	(5)	Providing trailers, modified containers, tents, and

other architectural and aesthetic items for the

homeless, including the possibility of securing land 1 to place these structures; and 2 Establishing campground fees for the homeless on a 3 (6) 4 sliding scale or for those who cannot afford to pay, 5 allowing campground users to contribute to the 6 maintenance of the area. (b) The Hawaii public housing authority shall submit a 7 8 report of its findings and recommendations, including any 9 necessary legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty 10 days prior to the regular session of 2009.

11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
