## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 466-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) There shall be a board of public accountancy to be
- 4 known as the state board of public accountancy, which shall
- 5 consist of nine members. All members of the board shall be
- 6 citizens of the United States and residents of this State.
- 7 Seven members thereof shall hold current licenses issued under
- 8 this chapter, of which six of the seven members shall hold
- 9 current permits to practice public accountancy and be in active
- 10 practice; and two shall be public members. For the purposes of
- 11 this subsection, "active practice" means engaging as a sole
- 12 proprietor, employee, or member or partner in the practice of
- 13 public accountancy for at least one thousand hours during the
- 14 prior calendar year."
- 15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2009.
