## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 84-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Every legislator and employee shall file a gifts 4 disclosure statement with the state ethics commission on June 30 5 of each year if all the following conditions are met: 6 (1)The legislator or employee, or spouse or dependent 7 child of a legislator or employee, received directly 8 or indirectly from one source any gift or gifts valued 9 singly or in the aggregate in excess of [\$200,] \$100, 10 whether the gift is in the form of money, service, 11 goods, or in any other form; 12 (2)The source of the gift or gifts have interests that 13 may be affected by official action or lack of action 14 by the legislator or employee; and The gift is not exempted by subsection (d) from 15 (3) 16 reporting requirements under this [subsection.] 17 section."
