5	certification or its equivalent issued by another state
6	government to permit the medical use of marijuana by a
7	qualifying patient or to permit a person to assist with a
8	qualifying patient's medical use of marijuana in that other
9	state shall have the same force and effect in this state as a
10	written certification issued by the department."
11	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
