# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish two full-2 time equivalency positions to enable the state fire council to 3 more effectively meet its responsibilities and to identify the
- funding source for those positions. 4
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 7 and to read as follows:
- 8 "\$132- State fire council; administrative staff. (a)
- 9 The state fire council may employ an administrator and an
- 10 administrative assistant, without regard to chapters 76 and 89,
- who shall hold their respective positions at the discretion of 11
- 12 the state fire council. The administrator shall have full power
- 13 to administer the affairs of the council, subject to the
- direction and approval of the council. The council shall 14
- 15 determine the amounts of compensation for the administrator and
- 16 the administrative assistant.
- 17 (b) The administrator of the state fire council shall be
